The Vatican has detailed how to gain plenary indulgences — *removing temporal punishment for sin through Christ's merits* — during the 2025 Jubilee Year.

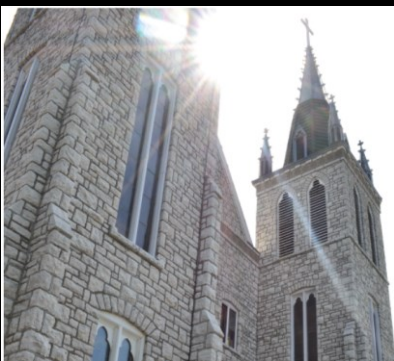

MARTYRS' SHRINE

Is a **national holy and historic space** honoring the lives of **St. Jean de Brebeuf** and **Canadian Martyrs**.



Featuring

-  stunning architecture
-  relics
-  beautiful grounds for reflection



The Shrine celebrates a nearly 400-year-old story of love and discovery that inspired and influenced the formation of Canada as we know it today .





Sainte-Marie was the **headquarters for the French Jesuit Mission.**

Wendake was the ancestral homeland of the Huron-Wendat nation.

French Jesuits came to Wendake in the 17th century. As an international order, they believed that the first step in saving one's neighbor was to educate him.
