Who can be nominated?

- A practicing parishioner of Divine Infant
- In full communion with the Church
- At least 18 years old
- Committed to serving the whole parish community

What does a PPC member do?

- Collaborates with pastor in planning and guiding parish goals and priorities
- Listens to parishioners
- Reflects on parish needs
- Helps communicate parish leadership decisions

Term and commitment

The term is two years and may be renewed once. Meetings are usually held once per month, on the last Wednesday evening of the month, with no meetings during the summer.

- Prayerful
- Collaborative
- Good listeners
- Open to serving all parishioners

Parishioners may nominate themselves or another eligible parishioner, provided the person has agreed to be nominated. A parishioner may submit more than one nomination.
